About this project

ACTION - (The HOW) describe how to get this done:

- I will be gathering coaches from the Eastern Region and working with them to create a plan for what exactly we'll be covering during camp; because these youth paddlers have varying levels of experience, we'll likely focus on paddling fundamentals.
 DESCRIPTION (The WHAT) describe the project and scope
- This project is a youth (U24 and Juniors) weekend (two-day) camp, hosted by a local youth team (TBD).
- At least two dragon boat sessions each day will be run, with an optional group dinner and perhaps a group bonding activity.
- If possible, I would love to get these kids on outrigger canoes, too (this especially will help for future Team USA Juniors time trials!).
- Purpose of this project is to provide more support and community to youth paddlers and help them grow their skills for the future.

BENEFIT TO ERDBA - (The WHY) list benefit(s) to ERDBA and/or Members:

- This project supports the small youth paddling community here on the East Coast and connects them over a two-day period; much better than a Zoom or phone call for these kids to actually bond and make friends.
- Similar to last year's camp, this camp will take place in May or June, at the beginning of the season, as a kick-off event for youth in the Eastern Region. The skills that kids learn during this camp will be easy to utilize and pass on during the remainder of the season

REQUIREMENTS - (The NEED) list support needed to initiate and complete project:

• Host club to provide: ~25x folding chairs, ~3x folding tables, ~4x folding tents, Dragon Boats, paddles, PFDs
