



## 2023 ERDBA GRANT OPPORTUNITY:

An important objective in the ERDBA five-year strategic plan is to “promote the sport and culture of dragon boating”. The ERDBA Board of Directors funded the ERDBA Grant Committee with \$3050 for 2023 to support ERDBA members in fulfilling this goal to help offset the costs of promoting the sport. **PLEASE NOTE WE CANNOT GUARANTEE 100% OF THE MONEY YOU ARE REQUESTING.** The \$3050 is the entire grant amount budgeted for 2023 and is to be divided by as many qualified requests as possible.

**YES:** Grant requests should show a positive impact on their Dragon Boat team, promoting the sport of Dragon Boating. Examples include but are not limited to: start-up costs for new teams, costs associated with paddler recruitment, mini-camp expenses, visiting coach fees, equipment for an introduction to dragon boating session (such as group pdfs) etc., unexpected expenses such as replacing a steering oar etc...

**NO:** Requests should NOT include regular club expenses. Examples include but are not limited to: insurance, coach remuneration, rent of equipment or dockage, race fees, uniforms, administration costs etc...
