PROJECT PROPOSAL TITLE: ERDBA Safety Tip Test

ACTION - (The HOW) describe how to get this done

- Seek 1-2 sites to purposefully tip a dragon boat with 10-12 paddlers on board.

DESCRIPTION - (The WHAT) describe the project

- Conduct a tip test for a dragon boat of 10-12 paddlers to help them drill on what to do.
- Allows regional officials to conduct their safety drill protocols on recovering paddlers from the water.

- Provide invaluable experience to paddlers in a tip over / swamping situation in a dragon boat.
- Allows regional officials to drill their safety protocols on recovering paddlers from the water.

- 1 dragon boat with 10-12 paddlers, a steerer and drummer
- 1 safety boat (can be a 2nd dragon boat on stand by, nearby to recover paddlers in water)
- 1-2 certified life guards
- All paddlers must properly wear their pfd's
- At least 6-7' water depth.
